# VALUES

- **Integrity.** Integrity is the cornerstone of all our actions and beliefs. Integrity embodies a number of ideas:
  - Veracity: all our communications, whether written or oral, will be accurate, forthright
  - Completeness: we eschew the idea that our beliefs and communications capture the essence of a point of view – we do not obfuscate our opinions through lack of clarity
  - Positivity: our actions and words are directed toward creating and sustaining the best possible world, we are altruistic in nature
- **Reliability.** Our opinions and actions reflect a consistent, dependable behavior. We will maintain a constant course of action and view of the world. Though minute changes may occur due to better information and knowledge, the overall tone of our organization will remain steady regardless of political or personal expediency.
- **Conservatism.** We are conservative in nature: personally, politically, socially. We value moderate behavior and beliefs; a society that holds to equality for all, compassion for all, acceptance of all.

Our members may hold a wide variety of views on various social issues but we recognize that individuals are unique. This may seem liberal in nature. The overall concept is acceptance, except in core values regarding the sanctity of life and natural liberties.

- **Justice and Tolerance.** These are key values. We believe ALL people deserve respect, courtesy, proper treatment, and humane care. We value people not according to race, religion, sexual preferences, gender identification, etc., but for an innate moral view acting inline to Divine laws
- **Perseverance.** We believe in staying the course. We live in a frenetic, chaotic world. To effectively deal with this environment, and sustain a noble, enlightened view, we must keep making the necessary efforts to create a just, compassionate, and inclusive society.
- **Liberty.** We believe in *“life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness”*. We do not believe that people should be bound to a set of strict, moralistic, or technical laws that inhibit certain ordained freedoms, rights, and liberties. We do not believe government should infringe on the rights of individuals or restrict individual liberties due to political differences, perceived threats to safety, or any other factors.
